# Eligibility

Participants must:

- Be a member with full playing privileges of their club.
- Have a Home Club which is a member of Golf Canada and in good standing, via membership with either Golf Ontario or Golf Quebec.
- Have a verifiable Handicap Index through a recognized Handicap system.
- Weekday, senior, junior and intermediate memberships qualify.

# Team Rosters and Substitutions

- Players' Indexes are frozen one week prior to your event.
- Team Rosters are to be emailed to each captain of your division and to the Intersectionals Director one week prior to your event.
- Team Rosters will list Alternates first. In the case of two Alternates, place the Alternate who would be first to play, first on the sheet, followed by the 2<sup>nd</sup> Alternate, followed by the remaining team players from highest to lowest indexes.
- Substitutions can be made up until the first tee time only.

# Caddies, carts and spectators

## Caddies

- Players and caddies should be advised that caddies are there for the player's benefit and should refrain from commenting or making suggestions to other players.
- Players and their caddies may not ride in the same cart.

## Carts

- OVGA policy of 2-cart maximum per foursome applies.
- One cart per club will be made available for Team Captains.

## Spectators

- May not give advice and should not attempt to communicate with players.
- Are not permitted to use motorized transportation at tournaments.
- Spectator Code of Conduct available for download at [ovga.org](http://ovga.org) under the "Tournament" tab.
- Non-playing Captains are permitted to communicate with players.

# Practice rounds

- In the spirit of play, the host club should provide a practice round to the visiting clubs.
- It will be up to the host club to offer a couple of choices for days and times as well as providing the cost for green fees and cart fee...possibly discounted. Visiting clubs should contact the host club to book times.
- These arrangements are entirely at the discretion of the host club and should be limited to only the players of a Visiting Teams (including the Alternate).

# Information to Share

- Team Rosters – each team should have received the Team Roster sheet to be filled out by each Captain and emailed to the other Captains in the division and the Intersectionals Director one (1) week prior to the event.
- Host Captain to host a Captains meeting 1 hour prior to the first tee time.
- The Captain's meeting should provide local rules if any, what tee blocks are being used, where to turn in scorecards, and where players should gather after play.
- Specific local rules (OVGA strongly supports the use of Summer Rules, but decision is the Host Club's). Make sure your players are aware what rules are in effect.
- Should a player complete their matches prior to the 18<sup>th</sup> hole they should sign the scorecard and exit the golf course.
- Following completion of round, all players should proceed to scoring area immediately.

# Food and Beverage

- The Host Club will provide a meal following play.
  - Each host club will receive monies from visiting clubs one week prior to the event for a meal for each team member and one non-playing captain/pro. \$300 - men's teams \$200 – women's teams.
- Each host club will send information via the **Host Club Information Form** as to the menu to each visiting club two weeks prior to the event.
- Each visiting club will email to the host club captain the total number of meals required and any special dietary needs one week prior to the event.
